What: The Hurstville Public Colour Run

As part of our Year 6 Fundraising activities, we will be holding a “Colour Run” on Thursday 25 March 2021. The Colour Run is all about fun! It will be a huge colourful mess and will undoubtedly become one of the most exciting days on our school’s calendar. Students will walk or run around the GRC oval and complete as many laps as possible whilst being showered with coloured powder. Students will raise money for our Year 6 gift to the school and receive a reward for their fundraising efforts. Family support is key to our fundraising success and we encourage everyone to get involved.

How Does My Child Fundraise?

Firstly, go to www.schoolfunrun.com.au and create a student profile page. Everything to do with your fundraising revolves around this page. Once you have completed this, read through your Sponsorship Form, which has instructions on how to raise money and order prizes.

Important information

The colour: The coloured powder is non-toxic, biodegradable and environmentally friendly, consisting of 98% corn starch and 2% food colouring. A small amount of this powder can cause breathing problems for anyone with asthma or other lung issues. Students with asthma are advised to wear a mask which can be purchased from the chemist.

The clothes: Students are to wear mufti clothing on this day. To heighten the effectiveness of the colour powder, we encourage students to wear a white t-shirt or top. The powder will likely wash out of your child’s clothing, however, there is the possibility of minor staining so we recommend your child wear old clothing, shoes and hat (school hats should not be worn for this event). Students travelling home by car or public transport may need to bring a towel or a change of clothing to change into after the event.

Staff will do their best to squirt powder at the torso of the students, however, wind and other factors may result in students getting powder on their face. Students may bring sunglasses or goggles to wear.

All students need to return the signed note to their teacher by Monday, 22 March, 2021.
