- Students with a surname A-L should be picked up from the school hall at 10.30am
- Students with a surname M-Z should be picked up from the school hall at 10.45am
- Complete an external visitors form for each visit
- Ensure that your child is well and free of any flu-like symptoms

Making Our School Safe


Gates are locked between 9.30am and 2.30pm. Use Forest Road gate for entry during this time.

- Listen to your child read or help them with their homework








Before and After School Care




Kindergarten Extra Curricula Activities

- Go to the toilet independently








Classroom Expectations

Preparing For The Big Day

- Reassure your child that someone will be at school to pick them up each day
- Practise writing your child's name



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

What To Do When The BIG Day Arrives

- It is important to arrive at the correct time indicated in your letter
- Smile try not to let your child see that you are anxious
- Take your child to their classroom, reassure them, hug and kiss them, and then say goodbye
- Be on time to pick up your child in the afternoon

> 2 Silver Awards = Gold Award


> 2 Gold Awards = Medal
