


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


Read *The Very Hungry Caterpillar* by Eric Carle. Use **Cut-outs** or **stickers** to show what the caterpillar ate each day.





Cut out Steggy and fold down the flaps. Lift the flaps to tell the days of the week.




 \Rightarrow Trace the patterns and letters using the starting points.



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
