- Any changes to daily routines




Making Our School Safe

- ▶ 1.10-1.20pm: Supervised Eating Time
- ▶ **1.20-2pm**: Play Time
- 3pm: School Finishes (Years 1 to 6)

 - the canteen












Playground Expectations

- Share equipment






Preparing For The Big Day

- Practise writing your child's name







Come along and meet other students starting Kindergarten in 2020 at Hurstville Public School.


When: Tuesday 28 January 2020

What To Do When The BIG Day Arrives

- Be on time to pick up your child in the afternoon

PBL provides a framework for the school and its community to collectively support the wellbeing of every student











Awards
