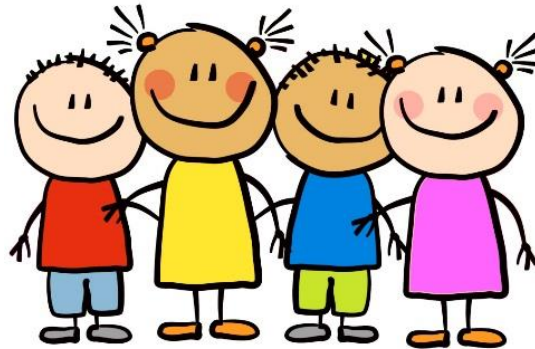
How will the learning and support team support your child?

To support your child, the team will:

- ❖ get to know your child
- ❖ work with your child's teacher/s to make sure their additional learning and support needs are identified
- ❖ organise the planning process, and design the supports for your child
- ❖ work with the whole school community and other professionals to improve learning for all students
- ❖ The learning and support team also assists in early intervention planning, processing and allocating resources.

How will I know if my child is receiving learning and support?

- ❖ You will receive a letter advising you that your child is receiving additional support.
- ❖ Please make an appointment to speak with a learning and support teacher, or the class teacher, if you have any further questions about additional support your child is receiving.
