
- ▶ Talk to your child's teacher on a regular basis

- ▶ Visitor's badge if you are visiting or helping in the classroom during school hours, you must get a visitor's badge from the office.









Bell Times

- ▶ **8.30am**: A teacher supervises students on Area 5 playground Students are not to arrive before 8.30am
- ▶ 8.40am: Bell rings and teachers are on duty
- ▶ 9am: School starts
- ▶ **11-11.25am**: Recess
- ▶ 1.10-1.20pm: Supervised eating time
- ▶ **1.20-2pm**: Play time
- 3pm: School finishes (Years 1 to 6)

- Go to the toilet independently










Classroom Expectations

Preparing For The Big Day

Before school starts:

- Try on uniform and shoes
- Make sure your child's name is on <u>everything</u>
- Let your child practise carrying their school bag
- Encourage your child to go to the toilet by themselves
- Reassure your child that someone will be at school to pick them up each day
- Practise writing your child's name

Positive Behaviour for Learning (PBL)


- PBL is an evidence based whole school process to improve learning outcomes for all students
