Showcase Final Reminder Dress Rehearsal Wednesday 13 November Concert Thursday 14 November Matinee 10:30am / Evening Performance 6pm

Dear Parents and Carers

This note outlines all the final arrangements for the 2019 Hurstville Public School Performing Arts Showcase on Thursday 14 November. The program attached outlines the order of performances. Please ensure your child arrives in the costume of their **first item**. All students can wear a Hurstville Public School shirt or jacket over their costume to travel to and from Hurstville Entertainment Centre. All students must wear appropriate shoes to travel to the Hurstville Entertainment Centre.

Daytime Dress Rehearsal- Wednesday 13 November

- Arrive at school by 8:45am dressed in costume for first item. Students may like to wear their HPS school shirt or jacket over the top of their costume.
- No makeup is required for the dress rehearsal.
- All other costumes, if any, are to be in a labelled large plastic snap lock bag and placed inside school bag.
- Band students to bring their instruments and music. We are hiring music stands for the performance.
- Bring recess, lunch and water in school bag (there will be no lunch orders for performers).
- 9am: all students go to their class to have their name marked on class roll.
- 9:15am: performers meet the supervising teacher of their first item under the shade cloth in area 5.
- Kindergarten dance groups will be meeting their teachers in Area 1 and they will walk as a group to Area 5.
- All performers are to have their name marked by their Showcase supervising teacher and board buses to Hurstville Entertainment Centre.
- By 3pm all students will have returned to school.
- Medication-supervising teachers will take your child's medication to the daytime rehearsal (if applicable) from school.

Matinee Performance- Thursday 14 November

- Arrive at school by 8:45am dressed in costume for first item. Students may like to wear the HPS school shirt or jacket over the top of their costume.
- Please refer to the accompanying overview outlining all hair and makeup required as the children will be performing in front of an audience.
- All other costumes, if any, are to be in a labelled large plastic snap lock bag and placed inside school bags.
- Students will be following the same procedure as above and will be leaving school from 9:30am.
- No student will be allowed to leave Marana Auditorium with a parent or guardian at the end of the matinee. All HPS students will be returning to school with their supervising teacher at the end of the matinee.

Evening Performance- Thursday 14 November

- All performers arrive dressed in their costume for first item at **5:15pm** (Band) and **5:30pm** (all other performers).
- Students in Years K-2, including Support Unit, are to be dropped at the Civic Theatre (enter via MacMahon St).
- Students in Years 3-6 are to be dropped at the Senior Citizens Centre (enter via Queens Rd via the MacMahon St carpark).
- Performers enter venue to meet supervising teacher.
- From 5:30pm audience enter main auditorium.
- 6pm: Showcase begins.
- 9pm: approximate conclusion of Showcase.
- No performers will be allowed to leave the venue before the end of the concert as all performers are in the finale.
- All students to be collected by an adult from the same venue they were dropped off (Years K-2 at the Civic Theatre) and (Years 3-6 at the Senior Citizens Centre).
- Medication- If your child is anaphylactic, please bring the home Epipen with you to the evening concert and keep it on you. The school will have first aid supplies backstage. Students should carry their own asthma puffers.
- Note Students need to bring a labelled bottle of water, their costume(s) and/or band equipment to the evening performance. Please eat dinner beforehand. No food is to be backstage.

Costumes- all costumes have either been given to students already or will be given out prior to Showcase.

All dance groups that rehearse with KRS dance teachers, Kindergarten Dance and Support Unit Dance will have information sheets, outlining costume requirements, inside the zip lock bag containing their costume. Please read through the information carefully.

NOTE FOR GIRLS- All girls' dance groups are encouraged to wear skin-coloured underwear underneath their costumes. For the matinee and evening performances, all girls are encouraged to wear makeup under the bright lights at the auditorium. Suggestions for makeup are foundation, blusher, natural tone eve shadow, red lipstick, black eveliner and mascara.

Program- Students are to arrive at school for the dress rehearsal on the 13 November, and matinee and evening performances on the 14 November in the clothes for their first item. All other costumes are to be in a labelled large snap lock bag. Below is an overview of the teachers who will be supervising your child during Showcase. Please discuss this with your child, as the names may be different to their usual supervising teacher and some teachers are responsible for multiple extra curricular groups.

The evening performance has sold out. There are still tickets available for the matinee via the trybooking website. Ticket sales will close at 11pm on Monday 12 November. If there are any tickets still available, they can be purchased at the Box Office in the foyer of Marana Auditorium from 10am. As you are aware, we are having the evening concert professionally recorded and edited. USBs of the performance can be purchased through trybooking for \$20, or at the matinee and evening performances.

We are all very proud of the students and look forward to watching them shine at the annual HPS Performing Arts Showcase. Thank you for your continued support.
